Southwestern Fertilizer Conference Joe Eddleman Memorial Scholarship Program

CRITERIA

- 1. Up to four \$2,500 scholarships will be awarded annually at the SWFC Annual Conference.
- 2. The scholarships are available to any relative of a SWFC participant who is currently enrolled, or will be within the next nine months, in an accredited advanced educational institution. Any major field of study will be accepted, although higher rankings will be allowed for students in agriculturally-based programs.
- 3. The application form must accompany the application, although additional information is encouraged.
- 4. Evaluations will be based upon the following criteria:
 - a. GPA/Curriculum
 - b. Community Service
 - c. Leadership
 - d. Work History
 - e. Study/Career Goals (although scholarships are not limited to any particular field)
 - f. 500 word essay, "Fertilizer's Role in Feeding a Growing World"
- 5. Three letters of recommendation, including one from an instructor, are required with the application.
- 6. High school and/or college course transcripts are required to be submitted with the application.
- 7. Scholarship payments will be made directly to the individuals.
- 8. The scholarships will be granted independent of any assistantship or scholarship currently held by the student.
- 9. Recipients are eligible for multiple scholarships from the SWFC.
- 10. There are no limitations to the number of recipients from any learning institution.
- 11. Applications must be received before January 15th, so that the committee can review them at the Annual Planning Committee meeting.
- 12. The SWFC Scholarship Committee will select and announce the selections before April 1 of each year.
